



The house rules apply to the Kultur- und Kongresszentrum Liederhalle (hereafter also referred to as the place of assembly) and the associated outdoor area. They apply to all persons entering the venue or the grounds or staying there. The domiciliary rights for the Kultur- und Kongresszentrum Liederhalle are exercised by in.Stuttgart Veranstaltungsgesellschaft mbH & Co. KG (hereafter referred to as in.Stuttgart) and the persons commissioned or authorized by it.

in.Stuttgart is entitled to restrict access to the exhibition grounds - in particular to the hall - for visitors, exhibitors and other third parties, e.g. to permit access only on presentation of an admission pass or ticket and to monitor compliance with the admission conditions.

Children and adolescents up to the age of 14 are only allowed to enter if accompanied by an adult. Any deviating regulations will be announced separately. Adolescents over the age of 14 have unrestricted access like adults. Event-related special regulations such as "for trade visitors only" remain unaffected.

Employees of in.Stuttgart and its appointed security companies are entitled to carry out ID checks on the premises. Persons who are found without a valid admission pass or are otherwise unauthorized in the hall or on the premises must leave the premises immediately.

Bags, containers and clothing such as coats, jackets and capes may be checked for their contents. Visitors who do not agree with the seizure of objects that could endanger the event or visitors by the control or order service will be excluded from the event. Rejected visitors are not entitled to a refund of the admission fee. In accordance with the nature of the event, the bringing of bags and similar containers into the event may be prohibited.

Persons who are recognizably under the influence of alcohol or drugs or who show obvious symptoms of illness will be excluded from the event. Smoking is prohibited in the place of assembly.

All facilities of the place of assembly are to be used carefully. Within the place of assembly, everyone must behave in such a way that no one else is harmed, endangered or - more than is unavoidable under the circumstances - obstructed or inconvenienced.

Any behaviour that is likely to disrupt the orderly conduct of the event or otherwise violates the legitimate interests of in.Stuttgart must be refrained from, in particular:

- Any unauthorized commercial activity on the event premises (in particular the offering of objects and services of any kind - against payment or free of charge);

- Unauthorized distribution or display of flyers, advertising leaflets, posters, magazines, etc., as well as the affixing of stickers of any kind;
- Bringing animals. Exception: assistance dogs;
- Parking of bicycles and the like in the place of assembly;
- Pollution of the hall areas or the open-air grounds as well as any behaviour that is likely to pollute or endanger the environment;
- Use of bicycles, scooters, kickboards, roller skates, in-line skates, skateboards and comparable means of transport in the place of assembly and on the premises;
- Unauthorized assemblies and processions of any kind.

Carrying the following items is prohibited:

- Weapons or dangerous objects, as well as objects that, if thrown, could cause bodily harm to persons;
- Gas spray cans, corrosive or colouring substances, or pressurized containers for highly flammable or harmful gases, except commercially available pocket lighters;
- Containers made of fragile or splintering material;
- Fireworks, rockets, Bengal fires, smoke powder, flares and other pyrotechnic objects;
- Flags or banner poles longer than 2 m or with a diameter greater than 1 cm;
- Mechanically and electrically operated noise instruments;
- Drinks and food brought to the event;
- Racist, xenophobic and radical propaganda material;
- Video cameras or other sound or image recording devices (unless the organizer has given its consent);
- Drones or similar flying objects may not be operated in the entire building.

Volume at music events: To reduce the risk of damage at music events due to sound levels, we recommend the use of hearing protection.

House bans imposed by in.Stuttgart apply to all current and future events held in the place of assembly. In.Stuttgart shall decide on the lifting of a house ban upon application at its reasonable discretion.
